Objectives	 FACTUAL KNOWLEDGE Remember sources and resources for funding opportunities and calls for proposals. List qualities of good scientific writing. Order the various written aspects of grant application packages logically. 		
	 CONCEPTUAL KNOWLEDGE Explain writing as a human and social activity. Describe the 4 recursive parts of the writing process. Assess research question quality and study design type. 		
	 PROCEDURAL KNOWLEDGE Compose high quality and complete grant writing components and materials. Differentiate techniques for improving the quality of grant writing components. Compose research plans for review by different audiences (ethics commissions, clinical trials). 		
	 METACOGNITIVE KNOWLEDGE Appropriately use personal strengths for medical grant writing. Execute a plan for creating grant application package materials. Achieve a successful reading and writing regimen to complete grant application
